- **Adaptive Content Engine** to strategically extend and configure the clinical workflow platform inside NextGen's EHR. With the most comprehensive clinical content and template customization functionality in the industry, the engine retains template customizations for easier upgrades so less time is needed to preserve or adjust custom workflows.

Among the other developments to be presented at this year's conference is [NextGen Healthcare's API Marketplace](#), a new approach to promoting innovation that complements the NextGen Enterprise platform.
